Regulation NO. 47 LIVINGSTON COUNTY

WC-47-99-001 LOUIS LAKE: SLOW—NO WAKE SPEED


On the waters of Louis Lake all within section 10, Town 4 North, Range 5 East, Deerfield Township, Livingston County, State of Michigan, it is unlawful for the operator of a vessel to exceed a slow—no wake speed.

The boundaries of the area described immediately above shall be marked with signs and with buoys. All buoys must be placed as provided in a permit issued by the Department of natural Resources and be in conformance with the State Uniform waterway marking system.

Adopted at a regular meeting of the Township of Deerfield on August 12, 1999.
