DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP

ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE A MORATORIUM ON THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, LICENSES OR APPROVALS FOR THE SALE OR DISPENSATION OF MEDICAL MARIJUANA

DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:

Section 1: Findings. In accordance with the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act, 2006 P.A. 110, and 1945 P.A. 246, as amended, Deerfield Township has determined that:

1. When Deerfield Township adopted its Zoning Ordinance, the Initiated Law 1 of 2008, the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act, was not contemplated.
2. Pursuant to the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act and 1945 P.A. 246, MCL 41.181 *et seq.*, Deerfield Township has the authority to establish reasonable regulations to control the sale and dispensation of medical marijuana in order to protect the public health, safety and welfare and in a manner consistent with the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act.
3. The Township desires to consider the best way to address the Michigan Medical Marijuana Act in order to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of Township residents.
4. Imposing a moratorium, on a limited temporary basis, is reasonable and necessary in order to allow time for review of and potential amendments to the Township's Ordinances and Zoning Ordinance.
5. A moratorium should be imposed upon the issuance of any and all permits, licenses and approvals for any property subject to or under the jurisdiction of the Deerfield Township Zoning Ordinance for the sale and dispensation of medical marijuana for six (6) months or until an

amendment to the Deerfield Township Ordinance and/or the Township's Ordinances, whichever occurs first.

Section 2: Moratorium. A moratorium is hereby imposed upon the issuance of any and all permits, licenses or approvals for any property subject to or under the jurisdiction of the Deerfield Township Zoning Ordinance for the sale or dispensation of medical marijuana, so long as this ordinance is in effect.

Section 3: Term of Ordinance. The moratorium imposed by this ordinance shall remain in effect for (1) six (6) months following the effective date of this ordinance or (2) until amendments to Deerfield Township's Zoning Ordinance and/or Township Ordinances become effective, whichever occurs first. Prior to the expiration of the six month moratorium, Deerfield Township may extend the moratorium for an additional three (3) months to allow sufficient time to complete amendments to the ordinances.

Section 4: Validity and Severability. Should any portion of this Ordinance be found invalid for any reason, such holding shall not be construed as affecting the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 5: Repealer Clause. Any ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed only to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.

Section 6: Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective immediately following publication.

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AN ORDINANCE TO IMPOSE A MORATORIUM
ON THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS, LICENSES OR APPROVALS FOR THE SALE

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Deerfield Township, Livingston County, Michigan, held at the Township Hall in said Township on November 11, 2010, at 7:00 p.m.

The following preamble and resolution were offered by Petchell
and seconded by Taylor.

WHEREAS, Public Act 246 of 1945, MCL 41.181 *et seq.*, as amended, authorizes a township board to adopt and amend ordinances that regulate the public health, safety and general welfare of persons and property; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and general welfare of persons and property to enact a moratorium for a limited and temporary basis to allow time for review of and potential amendments to Deerfield Township's Ordinances and/or Zoning Ordinance implementing appropriate and reasonable regulations to control the sale and dispensation of medical marijuana; and

WHEREAS, the Township Board has determined that adopting the Ordinance to Impose A Moratorium On The Issuance Of Permits, Licenses Or Approvals For The Sale Or Dispensation Of Medical Marijuana, attached hereto as Exhibit A, is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the Township residents.

2. The Township Clerk, in accordance with the MCL 41.184 shall publish either a true copy or a summary of the Ordinance once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Township within 30 days after adoption.
3. Any and all resolutions that are in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed.


