To be considered for a Hardship Exemption you must:

- 1. Complete the Hardship Exemption Form and return to the township ASAP.
- 2. Make an appointment at the March, July or December Board of Review, if you wish to appear in person.
- 3. What to submit to the BOR:
 - a. Hardship Exemption Form Completed & signed.
 - b. One copy of your 2024 Federal and State Income Tax Forms.

Important Note: PA 390 of 1994 states that the hardship exemption guidelines established by the governing body of the local assessing unit SHALL also include an asset level test. Deerfield Township approved an asset level not to exceed \$100,000 on 3-13-2008.
