

Deerfield Township Residents:

To be considered for a Hardship Exemption you must:

1. Complete the Hardship Exemption Form and return to the township ASAP.
2. Make an appointment at the March, July or December Board of Review, if you wish to appear in person.
3. What to submit to the BOR:
 - a. Hardship Exemption Form – Completed & signed.
 - b. One copy of your 2025 Federal and State Income Tax Forms.

DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP HARDSHIP GUIDELINES FOR 2026 ASSESSMENTS

Following are the poverty guidelines for use in setting poverty exemptions guidelines for 2026 assessments.

2026 HARDSHIP GUIDELINES FOR DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP	
Size of Family Unit	Hardship guideline
For families/households with more than 8 persons, add <u>\$5,700</u> for each additional person.	
1	\$19,550
2	\$26,400
3	\$33,300
4	\$40,150
5	\$47,050
6	\$53,900
7	\$60,800
8	\$67,650
For each additional person	\$6,875

Important Note: PA 390 of 1994 states that the hardship exemption guidelines established by the governing body of the local assessing unit SHALL also include an asset level test. Deerfield Township approved an asset level not to exceed \$150,000 on 12-11-25.
